



**Petit-Roy**

**Hautes-Côtes de Beaune  
Rouge 2021**

Variety:	Pinot Noir
Vine Age:	Planted in 1982-1984
Surface Area:	0.80 ha (1.98 ac)
Terroir:	Les Ronsins in Nantoux. Southwest-facing, on well-draining, mostly limestone soils with clay.
Viticulture:	Farmed by Seiichi, organic and biodynamic (not certified), 10 hl/ha.
Vinification:	100% whole cluster with minimal added SO <sub>2</sub> , 3-day cold maceration, long ambient yeast fermentation in 3850L tank with gentle punch-downs, mostly at the end of fermentation. Malolactic conversion during alcoholic fermentation.
Aging:	Aged for 12 months in used barrels and another 8 months in tank. No fining, no filtration. SO <sub>2</sub> added when racked to tank and before bottling (<7 ppm free, 14 ppm total SO <sub>2</sub> at bottling). Bottled May 15 <sup>th</sup> , 2023. 2,100 bottles produced.
