



## **Petit-Roy**

Pernand-Vergelesses 1<sup>et</sup> Cru Rouge Les Fichots 2021

Variety: Pinot Noir

Surface Area: 0.50 ha (1.24 ac)

Terroir: Southwest-facing, heavy clay soil with small stones.

Viticulture: Purchased grapes. Sustainable, 18 hl/ha.

Vinification: 100% whole cluster with minimal added SO2, 3-day cold

maceration, long ambient yeast fermentation in 1600 L tank with gentle punch-downs, mostly at the end of fermentation.

Malolactic conversion during alcoholic fermentation.

Aging: Aged for 12 months in used barrels and another 8 months in

tank. No fining, no filtration. SO2 added three times after being racked into tank (<7 ppm free, 37 ppm total SO2 at bottling).

Bottled May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. 1,200 bottles produced.
