



**Petit-Roy** 

Savigny-Lès-Beaune Rouge 2021

Variety: Pinot Noir

Vine Age: Planted in 1929

Surface Area: 0.16 ha (0.40 ac)

Terroir: "Les Vermots," hillside, southwest-facing, well-draining, clay-

limestone soil.

Viticulture: Purchased grapes. Organic, 42 hl/ha.

Vinification: 100% whole cluster with minimal added SO2, 3-day cold

maceration, long ambient yeast fermentation in 1600L tank with

gentle punch-downs, mostly at the end of fermentation. Malolactic conversion during alcoholic fermentation.

Aging: Aged for 12 months in used barrels and another 8 months in

tank. No fining, no filtration. SO2 added when racked to tank and before bottling (<7 ppm free, 21 ppm total SO2 at bottling).

Bottled May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023. 900 bottles produced.
