Savoie, France

Founded in 1853. Gilbert Perrier and his son are the fifth and sixth generation to make wine in this picturesque Alpine region. The domaine has slowly expanded over the generations, but maintaining quality has always been the priority. Vineyard work is sustainable; grapes are hand-harvested and gently vinified in stainless steel tanks.

The wines are classic, crisp, and pure Savoie character.

Cremant de Savoie NV 12/750ml

Despite the alpine location of Savoie, this region is a unique microclimate. Continental climate with alpine and Mediterranean influences. Vines in Savoie are often planted on mountain slopes. Despite their elevation, Savoie vineyards enjoy a surprisingly warm microclimate due to the southern/southeastern sun exposure and the moderating effects of nearby rivers and lakes.

85% Jacquere and 15% Chardonnay. Manually harvested and direct pressed. The second fermentation takes place in bottle for 12 months. Ageing on lees for nine months.
